Calculators

Students in Years 9, 10 and 11 require a scientific calculator. Students taking an academic maths program in Years 11, 12 and 13 require a graphics calculator. There are two types of calculators available. *These prices may vary with depending on the retailer*

1 Casio FX-82APlus Scientific calculator. Cost about \$48.

2 Casio FX9860G111 or FX-g750G111 Graphics calculator. Cost about \$194.
